REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

International Conference on Population, 1984Report of the Secretary-General

1. In its resolution 1981/87 of 25 November 1981, the Economic and Social Council decided to convene in 1984 an International Conference on Population under the auspices of the United Nations and requested the Conference to report to the General Assembly at its thirty-ninth session through the Council. The Conference was to be devoted to the discussion of selected issues of the highest priority, giving full recognition to the relationships between population and social and economic development with the aim of contributing to the process of review and appraisal of the World Population Plan of Action and to its further implementation.
2. In its resolution 38/148 of 19 December 1983, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to report to the Assembly at its thirty-ninth session on the outcome of the Conference.
3. The Secretary-General is making available, for the information of Member States, the report of the International Conference on Population, 1984, (E/CONF.76/19) which was held at Mexico City from 6 to 14 August 1984. It is expected that the Economic and Social Council will consider the report of the Conference at its first regular session of 1985. The results of its deliberations will be before the General Assembly at its fortieth session.
