## **Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly**

### **Report of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee)**

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2010, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-fifth session the item entitled “Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly” and to allocate it to all the Main Committees for the sole purpose of considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work.
2. The Fourth Committee considered the item at its 23rd meeting, on 11 November 2010 (see A/C.4/65/SR.23).

4. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.4/65/L.7 (see para. 5).
