INFORMATION NOTE

The United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA) is organizing a "Regional Meeting on Environment Statistics and Accounts and Evaluation of the ESIAP project" in coordination with the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) at the UN House, Beirut, during the period of April 7 to 9, 2010.

1. Background information

ESCWA and ECLAC have been implementing the development account project "Strengthening National Capacities in Environment Statistics, Indicators and Accounts in support of progress toward achieving the internationally agreed development goals in the ESCWA and ECLAC Region" with a total budget of \$602,000 and a duration from October 2007 to June 2010.

ESCWA and ECLAC provided assistance through training workshops, technical assistance missions, publication of studies and reports, and development of information systems, in coordination with regional and international agencies, particularly UNSD, the regional statistical cooperation programme between the European Union and Mediterranean partner countries (MEDSTAT), the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and other partners.

The objective of the project was to enhance the national capacities of Member States in environment statistics, indicators and accounts in order to integrate environmental concerns into economic development, thus supporting progress toward achieving environmental sustainability and related international agreed development goals member countries.

2. Purpose of the Meeting

The main purpose of the meeting is to evaluate the activities, outcomes and results of the project obtained so far, as well as the activities planned up to June 2010.

Also future capacity building needs in the countries concerned in the field of statistics and projects in relation to this will be discussed and addressed.

The discussions will also focus on ways to facilitate and improve exchange of experience and interaction between Western Asia and Latin America national statistical offices.

Delegates from countries are expected to share their experience and propose ways for future collaboration in the field of environment statistics and accounts.

3. Tentative agenda of the meeting

The meeting will take place during 3 days, 2 sessions per day, as per the following draft agenda:

Session 1: Reports on the activities of the Project

Session 2: Countries experiences

Session 3: Evaluation of the activities, outcome and results of the Project

Session 4: Regional and international activities

Session 5: Future in support of statistical capacity building in Environment Statistics and Accounts

Session 6: Conclusion and recommendations

4. Participation and registration

The meeting will bring together experts (statisticians, managers of environment statistics and/or national accounts) from National Statistical Offices, Ministries of Environment and Water Authorities in the Arab Countries.

International and regional experts from the UN Statistics Division, UN-ECLAC, Latin American countries and other concerned organizations are also expected to attend the meeting.

The nomination form to be filled by participants is attached.

5. Date and venue

The meeting will be held at the UN House in Beirut, Lebanon from 7 to 9 April 2010.

6. Documentation, methods of work and official languages

The working languages are English and Arabic. Interpretation will be available for both languages. Delegates are kindly requested to prepare a paper on: 1) their experience in environment statistics and accounts as related to the project; 2) their priorities of future support in the field; and 3) their proposals on ways to improve mutual interaction. Participants are expected to inquire on their entry visa requirements to Lebanon and to secure one ahead of their anticipated travel date. ESCWA may provide assistance to Palestinian or Iraqi participants on their VISA requirements.
