Official communiqué of the 6443rd (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday,
10 December 2010, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 10 December 2010, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 6443rd meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic and Chad.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard briefings under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Youssef Mahmoud, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic and Chad and, via video teleconference, from Major General Elhadji Mouhamedou Kandji, Force Commander of the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic and Chad and Police Commissioner Mamadou Mountaga Diallo, Head of the Police Component of the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic and Chad.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Mahmoud, Major General Kandji, Police Commissioner Diallo and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
