AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Appointment of members of the Joint Inspection Unit

Note by the President of the General Assembly

- 1. As indicated in paragraph 2 of document A/39/107/Add.1, the General Assembly is required, during its current session, to appoint a person to fill the unexpired portion of the term of office of Mr. Mark E. Allen (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) as a member of the Joint Inspection Unit. Mr. Allen has resigned from the membership of the Unit effective 21 September 1984.
- 2. In accordance with the procedures described in article 3, paragraph 1, of the statute of the Joint Inspection Unit, the President of the General Assembly, having consulted the regional group concerned, determined that the Federal Republic of Germany should be requested to propose a candidate to replace Mr. Allen (see annex I).
- 3. The President of the General Assembly has held the further consultations described in article 3, paragraph 2, of the statute of the Joint Inspection Unit, including consultations with the President of the Economic and Social Council and with the Secretary-General in his capacity as Chairman of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination. The replies received from the President of the Council and from the Secretary-General to identical letters addressed to them on 25 July 1984 by the President of the Assembly are attached (see annexes II and III).
- 4. Having completed the required consultations, the President of the General Assembly has the honour to submit to the Assembly the candidature of Mr. Siegfried Schumm (Federal Republic of Germany) for appointment as member of the Joint Inspection Unit for a term beginning immediately and expiring on 31 December 1986.

Letter dated 8 May 1984 from the Permanent Representative of Norway to the United Nations
