Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006)

Note verbale dated 25 January 2011 from the Permanent Mission of Qatar to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the State of Qatar to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006) concerning the Islamic Republic of Iran and, further to its note verbale dated 18 November 2010 (S/AC.50/2010/44), concerning the list of individuals and entities designated as subject to the travel ban and/or assets freeze pursuant to resolutions 1737 (2006), 1747 (2007), 1803 (2008) and 1929 (2010) (consolidated list), has the honour to inform the Chair of the following additional information:

The Civil Aviation Authority of the State of Qatar has provided Qatar Airways with Security Council resolution 1929 (2010). Any occurrence counter to the said resolution will be reported.

The concerned authorities in the Ministry of Business and Trade of the State of Qatar have been provided with Security Council resolution 1929 (2010) and have presented the following information:

- The Department of Corporate Monitoring and the Department of Registration and Commercial Permits have been coordinating in this regard so that applications for registration of new and currently registered companies are scrutinized for both individuals and legal entities involved in nuclear activities. If there is such a case, it will be reported.
- Marine agents throughout the country have been advised not to deal with marine freight companies specified in the said resolution.
- Actions taken by seaport authorities in case any restricted items are uncovered at Doha Seaport. The Ministry of Energy and Industry is also being similarly informed concerning ports operated by Qatar Petroleum.
