Official communiqué of the 6475th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday,
3 February 2011, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 3 February 2011, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 6475th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

“The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Roger Meece, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Meece, Lieutenant-General Gaye, United Nations Military Adviser and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views.”
