At precisely 7.30 a.m. on Thursday, 10 February 2011, an Israeli enemy patrol crossed the technical fence separating the area of the occupied Shab'a Farms with regard to which Lebanon maintains a claim from the liberated area on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba, penetrating some 20 metres into Lebanese territory. It remained there for some time before withdrawing into the occupied Shab'a Farms. This incident constitutes a flagrant violation of Lebanese sovereignty, Security Council resolution 1701 (2006), international law and the Charter of the United Nations, and a threat to international peace and security.
