Letter dated 19 March 2011 from the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to refer to my letter of 18 March 2011, notifying you of the intentions of the Government of the United Kingdom regarding measures pursuant to paragraphs 4 and 8 of Security Council resolution 1973 (2011) of 17 March 2011.

In accordance with paragraphs 4 and 11 of that resolution, I wish to inform you of measures the United Kingdom has taken, beginning on 19 March 2011, in coordination with other Member States, pursuant to paragraphs 4 and 8 of that resolution, as follows:

- Use of military measures to protect civilians and civilian areas under threat of attack in Libya, in accordance with paragraph 4 of the resolution
- Use of military measures to enforce a ban on all flights in the airspace of Libya, in accordance with paragraph 6 of the resolution

I would be grateful if you could circulate the present letter as a document of the Security Council.
