Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006)

Note verbale dated 9 March 2011 from the Permanent Mission of Colombia to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Colombia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006) and has the honour to refer to his note dated 4 February 2011.

Concerning the implementation of resolutions 1696 (2006), 1737 (2006), 1747 (2007), 1803 (2008) and 1929 (2010), the Permanent Mission of Colombia wishes to inform that:

- Colombia has transmitted to the relevant national bodies the Security Council resolutions concerning Iran's nuclear programme (1696, 1737, 1747, 1803 and 1929), with the request that they take the necessary measures for the implementation of those resolutions.
- Colombia has set up an inter-agency committee for the purpose of examining the requirements set out in the sanctions resolutions adopted by the United Nations Security Council, promoting domestic compliance with those requirements, and providing follow-up to the resolutions. The committee serves as a standing technical body for consultation, exchange of information and technical advice on matters relating to the various types of sanctions imposed by the Security Council. The members of the committee are:
 - Ministry of the Interior and Justice
 - Ministry of Foreign Affairs
 - Ministry of National Defence
 - Ministry of Trade, Industry and Tourism
 - Ministry of Mining and Energy
 - Administrative Department of Security (DAS)
 - Office of the Prosecutor General



- Directorate of National Taxes and Customs (DIAN)
 - Information and Financial Analysis Unit (UIAF)
 - Colombia's military industry
 - Department of Arms Trade Control
 - Superintendence of Notaries and Registries
 - Superintendence of Finance
 - Superintendence of Companies
 - To date the national Government has not received any information concerning any case involving a request to transfer or sell conventional weapons and related materials, equipment, goods and technologies related to Iran's nuclear programme or ballistic missiles programme, as specified in the Security Council resolutions or in the updated lists on the matter. It has likewise not received any information on requests for entry into or transit through the national territory from persons designated in the annexes to the Security Council resolutions or in their updated lists.
