Letter dated 1 October 1984 from the Chairman of the Committee on Conferences to the President of the General Assembly

Following the request by subsidiary organs of the General Assembly for an exception to be made to paragraph 34 of Assembly decision 34/401 which was communicated to you in my letter of 18 September 1984 (A/39/482/Add.1), I wish to inform you that further requests have been referred to the Committee on Conferences from the Ad Hoc Committee on the Drafting of an International Convention against Apartheid in Sports and the Committee of Trustees of the United Nations Trust Fund for South Africa, which each require one or two additional meetings in order to adopt their report.

The members of the Committee on Conferences considered these requests and did not object to them on the understanding that the meetings of these organs would be accommodated on an "as available" basis and that the work of the General Assembly itself would not be adversely affected.
