Summary statement by the Secretary-General of matters of which the Security Council is seized and of the stage reached in their consideration

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and in accordance with the note by the President dated 26 July 2010 (S/2010/507), the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

¹ Pursuant to the note by the President of the Security Council dated 16 March 2011 (S/2011/141), as from 16 March 2011 the previous consideration of issues pertaining to the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya under the agenda item entitled "Peace and security in Africa" has been subsumed under the new agenda item entitled "The situation in Libya". The Council first considered those issues under the new item at its 6498th meeting, held on 17 March 2011.
