Implementation of Security Council resolutions 1737 (2006), 1747 (2007), 1803 (2008) and 1929 (2010)

1. The Government of the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria has taken note of the adoption of Security Council resolutions 1737 (2006), 1747 (2007), 1803 (2008) and 1929 (2010) on measures taken concerning Iran.

2. Respectful of the decisions of the Security Council, it has informed the competent national administrations and institutions of Algeria's obligations under resolutions 1737 (2006), 1747 (2007), 1803 (2008) and 1929 (2010) and has instructed them to comply with those resolutions.
