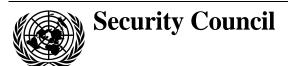

## Letter dated 6 May 2011 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the Security Council's presidential statement of 14 December 2010 (S/PRST/2010/26), in which the Council welcomed the extension of the mandate of the United Nations Integrated Peacebuilding Office in the Central African Republic (BINUCA) for a period of one year until 31 December 2011.
