Note verbale dated 2 May 1584 from the Permanent Mission of
Uruguay to the United Ivations Office at Geneva, addressed
to the Assistant Scoretaiy-Gencral for Human Rights

On instructions fron its Ministry of Foreign Affairs; the Permanent Mission of Uruguay has the honour to request the Assistant Secretary Genural to rectify the vote cast by Uruguay on rusolution $1934 / 54$ concerning the human rights situation in the Islamic Rupublic of Iran, adopted on 14 Itarch 1984 at tne 58 th meeting of the fortiath sussion of the Commission on Human Rights.

This votes which appears in tne records as a vote in favour of resolution $1934 / 54$, should in fact be rucorded as an abstuntion.

Unfortunatsly, Uruguay's dulegation to the Comission's fortieth session, acting without instructions from its ministry of roruign Affairs, made the mistak of departing unjustifiably from Uruguay ${ }^{7}$ s traditional position of abstention on this subjuct, as reflected in the docunents of the thirtyoninth session.

It whs only yusterday that the mistak canc to the notice of the Uruguayan linistry of Foreign Affairs. The Permanunt Mission would be very grateful if the Assistant SucrutarywGuneral would tak the necessary stups to ensure that uruguay's costuntion in the vots on Commission resolution $1984 / 54$ is recorded in the appropriatu monner.

Accordingly, the Uruguayan Permanunt Mission would request you to transmit thu taxt of this note to Mr. Petur Kooijmans, Chairman of the Commission on Human Rights, for inclusion in the ruport of the Commisuion on Human Kights to the Economic and Social Council, $2 s$ an officlal document of its fortieth session.
