#### ORGANIZATIONAL SESSION FOR 1984

# 1984/1. Review of the functioning of the Joint Meetings of the Committee for Programme and Coordination and the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination

The Economic and Social Council,

Recalling its decision 1983/173 of 28 July 1983, by which it decided to review, at its organizational session for 1984, the functioning of the Joint Meetings of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination and the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination,

Having considered the comments made in this regard by the Committee for Programme and Coordination and the Administrative Committee on Coordination,<sup>1</sup>

Having considered also, in accordance with the request made by the General Assembly in its resolution 38/227 B of 20 December 1983, the question of and application of paragraph 12 of General Assembly resolution 31/93 of 14 December 1976,

1. Decides that the Joint Meetings of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination and the

Administrative Committee on Co-ordination shall be held at Geneva on 2 and 3 July 1984;

- Decides also to review at its organizational session for 1985 the functioning of the Joint Meetings;
- 3. Recommends the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination and the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination to discuss at their next Joint Meetings the topic of the implementation of the International Development Strategy for the Third United Nations Development Decade with system-wide implications, and with special emphasis on Africa, by the organs, organizations and bodies of the United Nations system;
- 4. Endorses the conclusions and recommendations of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination,<sup>2</sup> as approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 38/227 B;
- 5. Decides to recommend to the General Assembly the continuation of the current application of paragraph 12 of Assembly resolution 31/93.

## 1984/2. Scheduling of the sessions of the Human Rights Committee established under the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights

The Economic and Social Council,

Recalling paragraph 5 (g) of its decision 1984/101 of 10 February 1984,

Having heard the statement made by the President of the Economic and Social Council on 4 May 1984 regarding the outcome of his consultations with the Chairman of the Human Rights Committee on the question of the scheduling of the sessions of that Committee,<sup>3</sup> and the views expressed by delegations on the matter,<sup>4</sup>

Decides to request the President of the Economic and Social Council to continue further his consultations with the Chairman of the Human Rights Committee and to report thereon to the Council at its organizational session for 1985.

### 1984/3. Measures to be taken following the cyclones and floods in Madagascar

The Economic and Social Council,

Having heard the statements made by the observer for Madagascar<sup>5</sup> and the representative of the Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Co-ordinator<sup>5</sup> concerning the four tropical cyclones and the floods which severely affected all parts of Madagascar in December 1983 and January and April 1984,

Recognizing that these climatic phenomena have resulted in loss of life and the destruction of several towns and have inflicted serious damage on the economic and social infrastructures and on the agricultural, stock-farming and agro-industrial sectors,

Taking into account the fact that those sectors are of fundamental importance to the economy of the country,

Recalling the resolutions of the General Assembly and the Economic and Social Council on assistance
