Letter dated 19 November 1984 from the Permanent Representative
of Afghanistan to the United Nations addressed to the
Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that the Chargé d'Affaires of the Pakistan Embassy in Kabul was summoned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan on the morning of 17 November 1984 and the following was pointed out to him by the In-charge of the First Political Department:

"According to the report of the concerned authorities of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, as a result of repeated shellings of heavy weaponry on 11 November 1984, by Pakistani Armed Forces stationed in the vicinity of the D.R.A. territory, against Barikot district, one nine-year-old child was martyred, a woman was severely injured and enormous material loss was suffered.

"The Democratic Republic of Afghanistan seriously condemns these repeated armed aggressions of aggressive armed forces of Pakistan against the D.R.A. territory and protests to the Government of Pakistan over such acts. It is further mentioned that Pakistan must, as soon as possible, prevent the recurrence of these provocative armed aggressions, otherwise the heavy responsibility for the grave consequences of these repeated aggressions shall be borne by the Pakistani authorities responsible."

I have further the honour to request Your Excellency to arrange for the circulation of this letter as a document of the General Assembly under agenda items 68, 69, 123, 124 and 129, and of the Security Council.
