6/... Drafting group on enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights

The Human Rights Council Advisory Committee,

Recalling Human Rights Council resolution 13/23, entitled "Enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights", in which the Council requested the Advisory Committee to explore ways and means to enhance cooperation in the field of human rights, taking into account the views contained in the report of the High Commissioner on the enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights (A/HRC/13/19) and further views from States and relevant stakeholders, and to submit proposals in this regard to the Council at its nineteenth session,

Recalling its recommendation 5/4, entitled "Drafting group on the enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights",

Noting that the Advisory Committee, at its sixth session held from 17 to 21 January 2011, continued its deliberations on enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights on the basis of the preparatory document A/HRC/AC/4/CRP.4 prepared by Mr. Decaux as Rapporteur of the drafting group,

1. *Notes* that the drafting group and the full Committee held meetings to discuss the matter under consideration;

2. *Takes note* of the preparatory document submitted by the drafting group and encourages the drafting group to revise it in the light of the discussions on the subject by the Advisory Committee and comments received from States and other stakeholders;

3. *Notes* that the drafting group will prepare a questionnaire for the approval of the Committee at its seventh session, which will subsequently be circulated to seek further views of States and stakeholders.
