ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION

To: Members of the staff

Subject: TRAVEL EXPENSES IN CONNEXION WITH ANNUAL LEAVE FROM DESIGNATED DUTY STATIONS

1. This instruction establishes the conditions under which staff members who are assigned to duty stations where conditions of life are particularly difficult shall be entitled to the payment of travel expenses to a suitable centre for the purpose of taking a substantial period of annual leave. It has been revised to show all the eligible duty stations and leave centres, effective 1 January 1975.

2. An internationally recruited staff member who has completed at least nine months' continuous service at a duty station listed in the annex to this instruction shall be entitled once in any calendar year to the payment of travel expenses from the duty station to the leave centre designated for that duty station for himself and eligible dependants who have travelled to the duty station at the expense of the Organization, provided that:

(a) He shall not be eligible for the payment of such expenses if he is entitled to annual travel to visit dependants, since his normal entitlement enables him to take leave away from the duty station each year;

(b) He shall not be eligible for the payment of such expenses in the same calendar year that he is entitled to home leave;

(c) He shall normally remain at a suitable centre for at least two weeks;

(d) He is expected to serve at the duty station for a further six months.

3. The travel shall be authorized by the most economical and reasonable route, mode of transportation and standard of accommodation. Travel time, travel subsistence and terminal and any additional expenses shall not be authorized. When the travel is by air economy class, excess baggage shall be authorized to the extent of the difference between the free allowance at economy and first classes.

4. The staff member may choose to travel under the same conditions to any other designated leave centre, or to any other place which would be suitable, provided that the amount of travel expenses payable to the staff member shall not exceed the amount which would have been payable for travel to the leave centre designated for the duty station. Payment of such travel expenses shall in no case exceed the cost of travel to the home country. Where by reason of a normal travel routing the staff member would be passing through his home country to reach the place designated as the leave centre, the travel expenses to the home country shall be paid.

5. Where possible, such travel and annual leave shall be taken in conjunction with travel on official business. It shall not normally be taken within nine months of proceeding on home leave or on annual visit to dependents.

6. An appropriate amendment to the Staff Rules will be issued in due course.

7. This instruction supersedes ST/AI/200 and Amend.1-4.
