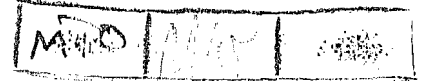

In addition to previous replies from Governments concerning prisoners of war (reproduced in documents A/AC.46/1 and Add.1 to 7), the Secretary-General has received further replies from governments (A/AC.46/1/Add.8 to 12), since the Ad Hoc Commission on Prisoners of War went into recess on 15 August 1951. In addition, he has received the following reply from the permanent representative of the United Kingdom at the United Nations supplementing previous information transmitted by him and contained in documents A/AC.46/1 and A/AC.46/1/Add.1.

UNITED KINGDOM

21 August 1951

The permanent representative of the United Kingdom at the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to invite reference to his note No. 197 of 4th June in which it was stated that further information might be communicated to the Secretary-General on the subject of prisoners of war.

More information has now been collected concerning Japanese prisoners of war who died or were executed in Hong Kong. A complete list^{1/} of these prisoners of war has now been prepared and a copy is transmitted herewith. It is regretted that it was not possible to furnish all the information at an earlier date.
