INFORMATION TRANSMITTED BY GOVERNIA CONCERNING PRISONERS OF WALL

Further to replies from governments concerning prisoners of war (reproduced in documents A/AC.46/l and Add.1-7) the Secretary-General has received replies from governments (A/AC.46/l/Add.8-13), since the Ad Hoc Commission on Prisoners of War went into recess on 15 August 1951. In addition he has received the following reply from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Burma supplementing the information contained in his earlier reply reproduced in document A/AC.46/l.

The Minister for Foreign Affairs presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and further to his Note No. INT457/G dated 4th May 1951 has the honour to state that the thirty Japanese War criminals who were detained in the Rangoon jail have now been repatriated to Japan. Copies of the letters of appreciation received from Ex. Col. Kume one of the Japanese War Criminals are enclosed for information.
