

Letter dated 14 July 2011 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 307 (1971), by which the Council decided that the United Nations Military Observer Group in India and Pakistan (UNMOGIP) should monitor the ceasefire line in the State of Jammu and Kashmir. The countries which currently provide observers are Chile, Croatia, Finland, Italy, the Philippines, the Republic of Korea, Sweden and Uruguay.

The Secretariat was notified by the Government of Italy, in early March 2011, that it intended to reduce its contribution of military observers starting in the second semester of 2011. Having completed the necessary consultations, I propose that Thailand be added to the list of contributors to UNMOGIP.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
