

6. Consideration of reports by States parties under article 35 of the Convention

At its sixth session, the Committee will consider the initial report received from the following State party: Spain.

In pursuance of established practice and in conformity with rule 41 of the rules of procedure, the Secretary-General has informed the State party concerned of the tentative dates on which its report is scheduled for consideration by the Committee. A schedule for the consideration of the report submitted is set forth in the annexed tentative programme of work.

7. Adoption of lists of issues on State party reports

The Committee will adopt lists of issues on the initial reports submitted by Peru and China.

8. Cooperation with United Nations bodies, specialized agencies, disabled persons' organizations and other competent bodies

The Committee will discuss how to strengthen cooperation with United Nations bodies, specialized agencies, non-governmental organizations, including disabled persons' organizations, and other competent bodies, to enhance the promotion and protection of the rights of persons with disabilities. Representatives of such organizations and bodies may seek to address the Committee under this item.

9. General comments and days of general discussion

The Committee will review the progress of work of the various task forces established to draft the general comments decided on by the Committee. To date, the Committee has decided to establish task forces on accessibility (art. 9) and legal capacity (art. 12). Another task force on access to public transportation and airline policies was also established and will report to the Committee but will not be the subject of a general comment.

The Committee will also discuss any proposals for future days of general discussion as may be presented by Committee members.

10. Methods of work of the Committee

The Committee will consider its working methods.

11. Future meetings

The Committee will be informed of any developments relating to its future meetings. It will also consider the organization of its future work.

12. Treaty body strengthening

The Committee will review the conclusions of the 12th Inter-Committee Meeting and the 23rd Meeting of Chairpersons, and consider the subjects it may wish to raise at the 24th Meeting of Chairpersons. It will also be updated on the process of treaty body strengthening, in particular the conclusions of various consultations that have taken place during the course of 2011 with States, civil society and other interested parties, and review the compilation of proposals that have been presented thus far by these various actors toward the strengthening of the treaty bodies.

13. Other matters

The Committee will discuss such other matters relating to the work of the Committee as may be necessary.
