INFORMATION FROM NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES TRANSMITTED UNDER ARTICLE 73 e OF THE CHARTER OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Fourth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Demetrio INFANTE (Chile)

- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 1984, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its thirty-ninth session the item entitled:
 - "Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories transmitted under Article 73 e of the Charter of the United Nations:
 - "(a) Report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples;
 - "(b) Report of the Secretary-General."

At the same meeting, the Assembly decided to allocate the item to the Fourth. Committee.

- 2. At its 2nd meeting, on 24 September, the Fourth Committee decided to hold a general debate covering agenda items 18, 103, 105 and 12, 106 and 107 on the understanding that individual proposals on matters covered by those items would be considered separately. The Committee held the general debate on these items at its 13th to 18th meetings, between 2 and 12 November.
- 3. The Fourth Committee considered item 103 at its 12th to 18th meetings, between 30 October and 12 November (see A/C.4/39/SR.12-18).

- 4. At the 12th meeting, on 30 October, the Rapporteur of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples made a statement in which he gave an account of the relevant activities of the Special Committee during 1984 and drew attention to chapter VIII of the report of that Committee relating to item 103 (A/39/23 (Part IV)) 1/ containing, inter alia, the related draft resolution submitted by that Committee for consideration by the Fourth Committee.
- 5. The Fourth Committee also had before it the report of the Secretary-General relating to the item (A/39/519).
- 6. In addition, the Fourth Committee had before it a note verbale dated 12 March 1984 from the Permanent Representative of Portugal to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General (A/39/136).
- 7. At its 18th meeting, on 12 November, the Fourth Committee adopted the draft resolution contained in paragraph 9 of chapter VIII of the report of the Special Committee (A/39/23 (Part IV)) by a recorded vote of 130 to none, with 3 abstentions (see para. 8). 2/ The voting was as follows: 3/

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FOURTH COMMITTEE

8. The Fourth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories transmitted under Article 73 e of the Chapter of the United Nations

The General Assembly,

<u>Having examined</u> the chapter of the report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples relating to the information from Non-Self-Governing Territories transmitted under Article 73 \underline{e} of the Charter of the United Nations $\underline{4}/$ and the action taken by the Committee in respect of that information,

Having also examined the report of the Secretary-General on the
question, 5/

Recalling its resolution 1970 (XVIII) of 16 December 1963, in which it requested the Special Committee to study the information transmitted to the Secretary-General in accordance with Article 73 e of the Charter and to take such information fully into account in examining the situation with regard to the implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples,

Recalling also its resolution 38/49 of 7 December 1983, in which it requested the Special Committee to continue to discharge the functions entrusted to it under resolution 1970 (XVIII),

- 1. Approves the chapter of the report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples relating to the information from Non-Self-Governing Territories transmitted under Article 73 e of the Charter of the United Nations;
- 2. Reaffirms that, in the absence of a decision by the General Assembly itself that a Non-Self-Governing Territory has attained a full measure of self-government in terms of Chapter XI of the Charter, the administering Power concerned should continue to transmit information under Article 73 e of the Charter with respect to that Territory;
- 3. Requests the administering Powers concerned to transmit, or continue to transmit, to the Secretary-General the information prescribed in Article 73 e of the Charter, as well as the fullest possible information on political and constitutional developments in the Territories concerned, within a maximum period of six months following the expiration of the administrative year in those Territories;
- 4. Requests the Special Committee to continue to discharge the functions entrusted to it under General Assembly resolution 1970 (XVIII), in accordance with established procedures, and to report thereon to the Assembly at its fortieth session.
