OFFERS BY MEMBER STATES OF STUDY AND TRAINING FACILITIES FOR INHABITANTS OF "NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES

Report of the Fourth Committee
Rapporteur: Mr. Demetrio INFANTE (Chile)

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 1984 , the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its thirty-ninth session the item entitled "Offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories: report of the Secretary-General" and to allocate it to the Fourth Committee.
2. At its 2nd meeting, on 24 September, the Fourth Committee decided to hold a general debate covering agenda items 18, 103, 105 and 12,106 and 107 , on the understanding that individual proposals on matters covered by those items would be considered separately. The Committee held the general debate on these items at its l3th to 18 th meetings, between 2 and 12 November.
3. The Fourth Committee considered item 107 at its 12 th to 18 th meetings, between 30 October and 12 November (see A/C.4/39/SR.12-18).
4. The Fourth Committee had before it the report of the Secretary-General relating to the item $(A / 39 / 541$ and Corr. 1 and $A / 39 / 541 / A d d .1$ and 2 ).
5. On 9 November, a draft resolution ( $A / C .4 / 39 / L .6$ ) on the item was circulated, which was finally sponsored by the following Member States: Angola, Australia, Bangladesh, Barbados, Bulgaria, Colombia, Cuba, Cyprus, Czechoslovakia, Egypt, Fiji, Guyana, India, Israel, Jamaica, Japan, Kenya, Madagascar, New Zealand, Nigeria, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Samoa, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Syrian Arab Republic, Togo, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, United Republic of Tanzania, United States of America, Vanuatu, Venezuela, Yugoslavia and Zambia.

6. At its l8th meeting, on 12 November, the Fourth Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.4/39/L. 6 without objection (see para. 7).

## RECOMMENDATION OF THE FOURTH COMMITTEE

7. The Fourth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

The General Assembly,
Recalling its resolution $38 / 53$ of 7 December 1983,
Having examined the report of the Secretary-General on offers by Member States of study and training facilities for inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories, 1/ prepared pursuant to General Assembly resolution 845 (IX) of 22 November 1954,

Considering that more scholarships should be made available to the inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territories in all parts of the world and that steps should be taken to encourage applications from students in those Territories,

1. Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General;
2. Expresses its appreciation to those Member States that have made scholarships available to the inhabitants of Non-Self-Governing Territuries;
3. Invites all States to make or continue to make generous offers of study and training facilities to the inhabitants of those Tertitories that have not yet attained self-government or independence and, whorever possible. to provide travel funds to prospective students;
4. Urges the administering powers to take effective measures to ensure the widespread and continuous dissemination in the Territories inder their administration of information relating to offers of study and trasining facilities made by States and to provide all the necessary facilities to enable students to avail themselves of such offers:
5. Requests the Secretary-General to report to the Generin Assembly at its fortieth session on the implementation of the present rescuution;
6. Draws the attention of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the implementation of the Declaration on the cranting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples to the present resolution.
