Appointment of a member of the Board of Auditors

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Ali Achraf MOJTAHED (Islamic Republic of Iran)

- 1. At its 39th meeting, on 30 November 1984, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/39/103) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the United Nations Board of Auditors which will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1985.
- 2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/39/51) containing the names of two officials nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the Board of Auditors.
- 3. The Fifth Committee voted by secret ballot to decide on its recommendation to the General Assembly. The result of the voting was as follows:

4. Having obtained the required majority, the Auditor-General of Ghana was declared recommended for appointment as a member of the United Nations Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1985.
