ADDENDUM TO BIOGRAPHICAL DATA OF THE

CHILE

Mr. Hernan Santa Cruz

Mr. Hernan Santa Cruz was born in 1906 at Santiago, Chile. Studied Military Law in Chile.

He was appointed in 1929 as secretary to the Superior Military Court, and from 1934 practised as a military attorney. In 1939, he became a judge of the Superior Military Court. He held the positions of professor of criminal procedure and military procedure in various Chilean military academies since 1930, and of legal adviser to the Secretary of the Interior since 1938.

Mr. Santa Cruz was a member of Chilean commissions for the study of the code of military justice and of the Social Security Act for the Armed Forces, and on the legal aspects of workers' insurance, workers' accidents, housing, and protection of mothers and children. He has been both secretary-general and president of the Chilean-Brazilian Institute of Culture and a member of the Chilean Office for Intellectual Co-operation. He has published articles on economic and social problems.

In 1947 he was appointed the Permanent Representative of Chile to the United Nations with the rank of Ambassador. He was the head of the delegation of Chile at the Special Session of the General Assembly, Second Vice-President of the Council at the fifth session of the Economic and Social Council, and First Vice-President at the sixth session of the Economic and Social Council.

License of Law from the Egyptian University, Cairo, with special courses in Public Law, Private Law, Political Economy and International Law.

Judge in the Mixed Courts 1944-1946.

Assistant Legal Counsellor to the Ministries of Foreign Affairs and Justice, in the Council of State.
