1. Mr. Laugiex, the Assistant Secretary-Goneral for Social Affairs, opened the meoting at 5:10 PM. In his speech welenoing the members - Mr. Laugier teld them of the tremendous work awattiag them which might be based an the previnus studies undertaken by the Committee of Experts of the League of Nations. He mentioned that there were proeressive laws In many countries but atressed the fact that, on the one hand, they had not beon applied and an the other hand, women had first to recelve pelitical education. The subucrmission had onily a short time in which to report to the Commigainn on Human Rights and, therefore, it was processary to get down to the agenda forthwith.
2. The electin of the chaiman, On the namnatien of Miss Bemerdino, pers. Begtrup was elected by acclamation.

World public opinion had to strengthen the equality nf men and women, a principle stated in the charter of the United Nations, The creation of the sub-comaission was giving hope to mulliens of women and must mot decoive "them:"
3. Adpption of rules of procedure. The chatrman then read the rulces of procedure which were adopted unanimnusly with the addition of the proviainn in Rule $I$ for "a rapporteur in addition to vico-chairman.
4. Election of vice-chairman. The chairmen then called for nomination for vice-chairman. Miss Rernardino was neminated by Miss Jurdak and Miss Kalinowska by Mr. Brkish. A vote was taken by secret bailot and Miss Bemardino was elected as vice-chairman.

In replying, Mise Bernardino paid a tribute to the preaident and members of the Economic and Social Council for the creation of this sub-comission and recognized the initiative.. of feminist movements in Latin America. She offered to place her experience as chatrman of the Inter-American Commigsion of Women at the disposal of the sub-comnisaion. Miss Bernardino suggestod that the sub-commission should invite qualified men to work with it in order to help establish permanent equal civil, ecanomic, social and political rights for women throughout the wrild. This goal could be attained by a charter: In conclusion, she remarkod that the time had come for roalistic action.
