The Chairman opened the meoting at 3:00 PM and drew the attention of the members to an invitaiton to members of the Sub-commiasion received from the Australian Women's Conference arranged in Sydney during August. It weas agreed that a telegrem should be sent in reply thanking the women we of Auctralia, regrotting the inability of rombers to acoept, and promialng to send a copy of the report of the Sub-commisaion when completed.

The Chairman then read a draf't text defining the broad purpose of the Sub-commiseim as followe:

Freedom and equelity are esesential to human developments and whereas woinn is as much a humen being as man and, therefore, emitied to share tham with hin;

We believe that well-belng end progrese of society depend on the extent to whioh both men and women are able to develop their full personality and are cognizant of their responelibilitios to themselves and to each other:

We belieye that a woman has thus a definite role to play in the building of a free, healthy prosperous and moral gociety and that she can fulfil thia obligation only as a free and responaibilo. member:

In order to achleve this ideal the purpose of the commasion is to raise the status of woman to equality with man in all fields

On the motion of Mrs．Ronsevelt this text was adopted unanimously The meeting adjourned at 3：10 P．M．until Frj．day 3 May，10：30 A．M．
