REPORT OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE ISRAELI PRACTICES AFFECTING THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF THE POPULATION OF THE THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

Report of the Secretary-General

(in pursuance of General Assembly resolution 38/79 A)

- 1. At its thirty-eighth session, the General Assembly adopted resolution 38/79 A on 15 December 1983. In paragraph 2 of that resolution, the Assembly demanded the immediate release of Ziad Abu Eain as well as the other prisoners who were duly registered to be freed from Insar Camp and other military command posts in southern Lebanon but have not in fact been released, and the securing of their transfer to Algiers in conformity with the agreement reached through the good offices of the International Committee of the Red Cross. In paragraph 3 of the same resolution the Assembly requested the Secretary-General to report on the implementation of the resolution.
- 2. In order to enable the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly, the Permanent Representative of Israel to the United Nations was informed by a note verbale dated 13 October 1984 that the Secretary-General would appreciate it if any pertinent information which the Government of Israel might have on the question raised in paragraph 2 of Assembly resolution 38/79 A would be communicated to him. At the time of reporting, no reply had been received.
- 3. It may be recalled that at the thirty-eighth session of the General Assembly the representative of Israel made a statement on the matters referred to in resolution 38/79 A (see A/SPC/38/SR.47).
