ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION

To: Members of the Staff of the United Nations

Subject: APPROVED ROUTES OF TRAVEL AND RATES OF ALLOWANCES

In accordance with the agreement reached by the Consultative Committee on Administrative Questions at its last session, this instruction, effective 1 June 1953, revises Annex II of Administrative Instruction ST/AFS/AI/96 of 26 February 1953, showing the areas classified under group 2 and group 3 for travel subsistence allowance purposes.

Group 1 rates as shown in the above table shall apply for all areas other than those which are designated as belonging to Groups 2 or 3.

Group 2 rates as shown in the above table shall apply in the case of stop-overs of more than 24 hours in any of the following areas:

Group 3

Special minimum rates are established for the areas indicated below.

Where Group 1 rates are higher, they shall apply in lieu of these special rates.
