# GENERAL DISCUSSION ON TRANSPORT ISSUES IN THE ARAB MASHREQ: FIRST MEETING OF THE WORKING GROUP ON THE HARMONIZATION OF INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORKS AND LEGISLATION IN THE TRANSPORT SECTOR IN THE ESCWA REGION

#### **Summary**

Pursuant to one of the recommendations made by the Committee on Transport at its eleventh session (Beirut, 22-24 March 2010), on the nomination of member country representatives to the Working Group on the Harmonization of Institutional Frameworks and Legislation in the Transport Sector in the ESCWA Region, Egypt, Jordan, Oman, Palestine, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, the Syrian Arab Republic, the United Arab Emirates and Yemen sent the names of their representatives to the Working Group.

This document contains the provisional agenda proposed by the secretariat for the first meeting of the Working Group. Proposed topics for discussion were based on the objectives, functions, membership, meetings and working period of the Group. The agenda is submitted to the members for discussion and adoption before the Group proceeds with the discussions of the first meeting.

#### Introduction

- 1. Since 2008, the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA) allocated a significant part of its transport-related activities to the harmonization of institutional frameworks and legislation in the transport sector in the ESCWA region. In this context, ESCWA prepared a proposal to form the Working Group on the Harmonization of Institutional Frameworks and Legislation in the Transport Sector in the ESCWA Region which included its objectives, functions, membership, meetings and timeframe. The proposal was submitted to the eleventh session of the Committee on Transport which discussed it and ratified the revised draft proposal dated 24 March 2010. ESCWA secretariat recommended that member countries name their representatives to the Working Group by the end of August 2010. Accordingly, Egypt, Jordan, Oman, Palestine, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, the Syrian Arab Republic, the United Arab Emirates and Yemen sent the names of their representatives to the Working Group.
- 2. This document contains a list with the Working Group named members as well as the provisional agenda of the first meeting. ESCWA representatives participate in the discussions of this meeting as members on behalf of the Commission.
