Annex to the identical letters dated 5 December 2011 from the Permanent Representative of Lebanon to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council

On 29 November 2011 between 0105 hours and 0120 hours, Israeli enemy forces fired four 155 millimetre artillery shells towards Lebanese territory. The shells landed on the outskirts of Ayta al-Sha'b and Rumaysh at the following coordinates: Q:719852-N:663317, Q:719567-N:663325 and Q:719828-N:663315.

This action is a flagrant infringement of Lebanese sovereignty, Security Council resolution 1701 (2006), international law and the Charter of the United Nations, and a threat to international peace and security.
