

The meeting was called to order at 10.10 a.m.

Adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted.

The President (*spoke in Russian*): Under rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure, I invite the representative of Rwanda to participate in this meeting.

The Security Council will now begin its consideration of the item on its agenda.

Members of the Council have before them document S/2011/787, which contains the text of a

draft resolution submitted by Portugal. I wish to draw the attention of Council members to document S/2011/731, which contains a letter dated 16 November from the President of the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda addressed to the President of the Security Council; document S/2011/780, which contains an identical letter dated 16 December 2011 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the General Assembly and the President of the Security Council; and document S/2011/781, which contains an identical letter dated 20 December 2011 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the General Assembly and the President of the General Assembly and the President of the Security Council.

It is my understanding that the Council is ready to proceed to the vote on the draft resolution before it. I shall put the draft resolution to the vote now.

A vote was taken by show of hands.

In favour:

Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, China, Colombia, France, Gabon, Germany, India, Lebanon, Nigeria, Portugal, Russian Federation, South Africa, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and United States of America.

The President (*spoke in Russian*): There were 15 votes in favour. The draft resolution has been adopted unanimously as resolution 2029 (2011).

The Security Council has thus concluded the present stage of its consideration of the item on its agenda. The Council will remain seized of the matter.

The meeting rose at 10.15 a.m.
