## Recommendation Web-based Information System for Protocol V (WISP.V)

## Submitted by the Coordinator on WISP.V1

- 1. This year there will not be a formal report on WISP.V, instead during the Fifth Conference the Coordinator will be making a presentation on its establishment and formally launching the system. For the purposes of ensuring the system's ongoing implementation and maintenance, the following recommendation is proposed:
- (a) The Conference welcomed the establishment of the Web-based Information System for Protocol V (WISP.V).
