CORRIGENDUM TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF THE HUNDRED AND TWELFTH MEETING

Held at Lake Success, New York, on Friday, 3 June 1949, at 11 a.m.

Page 3, lines 33 to 35:

Delete the last sentence of the last paragraph, and substitute the following:

"There was also the practical difficulty of deciding in certain circumstances whether a sentence involving longer detention was more severe. Was three years' Borstal detention, for instance, a more severe sentence than two years' imprisonment? She could not agree that to increase the penalties for crimes with retroactive effect could be regarded as a violation of any fundamental human right."
