# REPORT OF THE BOARD OF AUDITORS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE ACCOUNTS OF THE VOLUNTARY FUNDS ADMINISTERED BY THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 1963

1. The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) submitted the following financial statements, together with associated schedules for audit certificates:

- I. Statement of assets and liabilities as at 31 December 1963;
- II. Statement of income, expenditure, surplus and balances for the year ended 31 December 1963;
- III. Schedule 1. Cash and investments as at 31 December 1963;
- IV. Schedule 2. Statement of loan operations;
- V. Schedule 3. Statement of income of UNHCR 1963 programmes;
- VI. Schedule 4. Statement of income and expenditure of Emergency Fund;
- VII. Schedule 5. Detailed statement of income—relief operation in Algeria for year ended 31 December 1963;
- VIII. Schedule 6. Statement of expenditure—transmission of contributions for the year ended 31 December 1963;
- IX. Schedule 7. Detailed statement of income of restricted funds for the year ended 31 December 1963;
- X. Schedule 8. Statement of income, expenditure and balances of restricted funds as at 31 December 1963;
- XI. Schedule 9. Statement of income and expenditure of Indemnification Fund.

2. The administrative expenditure of UNHCR for 1963 was \$2,565,199.42. Against this, a sum of \$600,000 was paid to the United Nations in a global amount as a grant-in-aid of the administrative cost, out of the 1963 major aid programme.

3. The assets of all voluntary, restricted and trust funds as at 31 December 1963 totalled \$32,070,917.63. Liabilities totalled \$29,323,194.08. The assets thus exceeded liabilities by \$2,747,723.55, the break-down being:

#### UNSPENT BALANCES OF ADVANCES TO VOLUNTARY AGENCIES

6. It has been noted that unspent balances of advances made to agencies for implementation of projects in a number of cases had not been recovered by the UNHCR in accordance with the terms of agreements. In one case ANS 780,000.00 were advanced to an agency out of which an amount of ANS 624,000 became refundable to UNHCR due to reduction in the size of the project under the amended agreement. Since the agency was not in a position to refund the amount as a lump sum, the UNHCR agreed to receive repayment in instalments. The first instalment of ANS 6,000 was to be paid in August 1962 and another amounting to ANS 20,000 in September 1963. The balance thereafter was to be paid in 46 years in yearly instalments of ANS 13,000 on 15 March of each consecutive year beginning 15 March 1964 and no interest was to be charged.

7. In another case of a housing project the agency was required to refund \$1,233.05 in five yearly instalments of \$247.94 beginning 1 January 1964 and no interest was to be charged on the amount recoverable.

8. In still another case it was agreed to recover the unspent amount of \$7,665.51 in four half-yearly instalments.

9. In the case of 10 projects completed in Greece by 31 December 1960, an amount of \$240,000.00 out of UNHCR funds had remained unutilized. As a result of negotiations the Greek Government agreed to refund \$223,064.00 to the UNHCR. An amount of \$60,133.23 had been recovered by the end of 1963 and the balance of \$162,930.77 was still outstanding at 31 December 1963.

10. It will thus be noted that considerable funds of the UNHCR representing its contribution to agencies for the implementation of projects have remained unutilized and unrecovered. Normally the unspent balances should have been refunded by the agencies to the UNHCR within a reasonable time after the completion of projects. However, as mentioned above, the unspent balances have assumed the nature of interest free loans to the agencies and are refundable in instalments over a long period. This being the position, such balances should be shown as outstanding loans against agencies in the UNHCR accounts.

11. If the unspent balances had been refunded to the UNHCR by the agencies in lump sums they could have been utilized against current programmes.

12. In the circumstances explained above the Board of Auditors considers that it is desirable to carry out a complete review of the unspent balances refundable to UNHCR with a view to securing refunds in the foreseeable future.

#### CONVERSION OF LOANS INTO GRANTS AND WRITE-OFF

13. It was observed that though the agreement did not provide for the conversion of any portion of the loans into grants, up to the end of 1963, irrecoverable loans to the extent of \$180,614.75 were, instead of being written off, converted into grants. In the year 1963 the amount of such loans converted into grants was \$38,949.40. As was pointed out in paragraph 9 of the Memorandum last year loans becoming irrecoverable should be written off. The Board reiterates the suggestion.

#### PROJECTS IN GREECE

14. The Board feels concerned on the situation of accounts relating to projects in Greece. Beside the fact that the Greek Government did not, in the past, render any financial statements to the UNHCR, the figures in the books of the Government of Greece were not susceptible to proper check as the funds were incorporated in the National Budget of Greece. The Greek Government up till now has not made any repayment of loans. Moreover, some of the projects being partly on grant and partly on loan basis the amount of loans as distinct from the amount of grants cannot be accurately determined till the projects are completed.

15. Non-submission of the financial statements of the projects in the past by the Greek Government and accounting of the projects in the Greek language made it difficult for the Internal as well as the External Audit to exercise a proper check. Although to overcome the difficulty the UNHCR, with the concurrence of the Government of Greece, made an arrangement for the audit of these accounts by an official of the office of the Auditor General of Greece, the audit so far conducted by him was confined to cash payments only and was conducted in accordance with the Greek law and not with reference to the agreements of these projects. The position being this, it is clear that the expenditure debited to the projects by the Greek Government by book adjustments was not checked at any stage on behalf of the UNHCR.

16. In the light of the situation explained in the foregoing paragraphs, the Board of Auditors considers that early concentrated effort is needed to find solutions to the financial and accounting problems concerning the projects in Greece.

#### UNREF PROGRAMME

17. In regard to certain projects the UNHCR has granted a moratorium to an agency for the financing of additional cost in the amount of ANS 221,102.76 (\$8,559.92). Under the moratorium the Agency has been permitted to use the loan repayments received from the Refugees by the agency for further financing of the combined projects. The implications of this action are that the transaction does not appear in the accounts and remains invisible; the funds representing the repayment of loans during the two-year period of moratorium are not available for allocation to new projects and the total amount of an old completed project under a completed programme has been increased indirectly by the UNHCR without obtaining the approval of the Executive Committee.

18. The Board of Auditors records its appreciation for the assistance rendered to the External Auditors by the United Nations High Commissioner and his staff and by the Internal Audit Service.
