Addendum to the note by the Secretary-General

Under C. Customs Inspection of Luggage, paragraph (iii) (a),

1. First sentence: instead of the present text, read:

"The Egyptian Government finds that it **is** unable to adopt the proposal which gives the option to the passenger to have his baggage inspected in inland checking offices before its dispatch to the frontier en route for abroad."

2. Last sentence: instead of:

"...no <u>internal</u> customs inspection offices...", read: "...no <u>inland</u> customs inspection offices...".
