1. Adoption of the agenda of the organizational meeting

The Committee may wish to adopt the agenda of its organizational meeting.

2. Election of the President of the seventeenth session

Rule 10 of the rules of procedure provides for the election by the Committee of the President at the beginning of the session. Rule 40 provides that all elections shall be held by secret ballot unless the Committee decides otherwise in an election in which the number of candidates does not exceed the number of elective places to be filled.

3. Election of officers other than the President

Rule 10 of the rules of procedure of the Committee provides that, in addition to the President, the Committee shall elect three Vice-Presidents and a Rapporteur, and rule 40 provides that all elections shall be held by secret ballot unless the Committee decides otherwise in an election in which the number of candidates does not exceed the number of elective places to be filled.



4. Adoption of the agenda of the seventeenth session and organization of work

The Committee may further wish to decide on its organization of work on the basis of suggestions by the secretariat (SSC/17/L.3).
