GUATEMALA

The Convention was approved by Decree 704 of the Congress of the Republic ... accordingly, its provisions are binding in this country.

TURKEY

[Original: English]
13 August 1969

Since provisions for the prevention and punishment of the crime of genocide already exist in the Turkish Criminal Law and in the related legislations, no other new measures have been taken to give effect to the convention on genocide.
