INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Status of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, by its resolution 2200 A (XXI) of 16 December 1966, adopted and opened for signature, ratification or accession the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, and expressed the hope that the Covenants and the Optional Protocol would be signed, ratified or acceded to without delay and would come into force at an early date. The Assembly also requested the Secretary-General to submit to it at its future sessions reports concerning the status of ratifications of the Covenants and of the Optional Protocol. In response to that request, reports on the status of the International Covenants and the Optional Protocol have been submitted annually to the Assembly since its twenty-second session in 1967.
- 2. Both Covenants and the Optional Protocol were opened for signature at New York on 19 December 1966. In accordance with their respective provisions, 1/ the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights entered into force on 3 January 1976, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights entered into force on 23 March 1975, and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, having received the required number of ratifications or accessions, entered into force simultaneously with that Covenant on 23 March 1976.

- 3. By its resolution 43/114 of 8 December 1988, the General Assembly, inter alia, again urged all States that had not yet done so to become parties to both Covenants, as well as to consider acceding to the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights; invited the States parties to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights to consider making the declaration provided for in article 41 of the Covenant and appealed to States parties to review whether any reservation made in respect of the provisions of both Covenants should be upheld. The Assembly also requested the Secretary-General to submit to it at its forty-fourth session a report on the status of the Covenants and the Optional Protocol.
- 4. As at 1 August 1989, the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 92 States, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 87 States and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights had been ratified or acceded to by 45 States. In addition, seven States had signed the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and five States had signed the Optional Protocol. The list of States which have signed, ratified or acceded to the Covenants and the Optional Protocol and the dates of their signatures, ratifications or accessions appear in annexes I to III of the present report.
- 5. Upon ratification of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, or subsequently, the Governments of Argentina, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Congo, Denmark, Ecuador, Finland, the Gambia, Germany, Federal Republic of, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Peru, the Philippines, Senegal, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland made the declaration provided for in article 41 of the Covenant, recognizing the competence of the Human Rights Committee established under article 28 of the Covenant to receive and consider communications to the effect that a State party claims that another State party is not fulfilling its obligations under the Covenant. The provisions of article 41 entered into force on 28 March 1979 in accordance with paragraph 2 of that article.
- 6. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, established in accordance with Economic and Social Council resolution 1985/17 of 28 May 1985, held its third session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 6 to 24 February 1989. It submitted a report to the Economic and Social Council at its first regular session of 1989, 2/ in which it made suggestions and recommendations concerning issues arising from the consideration of reports submitted by States parties to the Covenant.
- 7. By its resolution 1989/81 of 24 May 1989, the Economic and Social Council, inter alia, took note with appreciation of the report of the Committee on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights on its third session, and decided to transmit the report of the Committee to the General Assembly at its forty-fourth session for consideration under the agenda item entitled "International covenants on Human Rights".

8. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Human Rights Committee held its thirty-fourth session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 24 October to 11 November 1988, its thirty-fifth session at United Nations Headquarters from 20 March to 7 April 1989 and its thirty-sixth session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 10 to 28 July 1989. In accordance with article 45 of the Covenant and article 6 of the Optional Protocol, the Committee has submitted its annual report to the General Assembly at its forty-fourth session, 3/ which covers the activities of the Committee at its thirty-fourth, thirty-fifth and thirty-sixth sessions.

b/ Following on the adoption by the General Assembly of resolution 2758 (XXVI) of 25 October 1971 on the restoration of the lawful rights of the People's Republic of China in the United Nations, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, by a note addressed to the Secretary-General, received on 29 September 1972, stated:

[&]quot;1. With regard to the multilateral treaties signed, ratified or acceded to by the defunct Chinese government before the establishment of the People's Republic of China, my Government will examine all their contents before making a decision in the light of the circumstances as to whether or not they should be recognized.

[&]quot;2. As from 1 October 1949, the day of the founding of the People's Republic of China, the Chiang Kai-Shek clique has no right at all to represent China. Its signature and ratification of, or accession to, any multilateral treaties by usurping the name of 'China' are all illegal and null and void. My Government will study these multilateral treaties before making a decision in the light of the circumstances as to whether or not they should be acceded to."
