As indicated in annex IV of the Secretary-General's report, the amount owed to troop- and police-contributing countries by closed peacekeeping missions that are in cash deficit amounted to \$63.1 million as at 30 June 2011.

2. Paragraph 15

The second sentence *should read*

However, the Committee was informed that owing to cash shortages on account of unpaid assessed contributions, the payments for troop and formed police unit costs had been paid only up to August/September 2011 for the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force, the United Nations Mission in the Sudan, the United Nations Mission in South Sudan, the United Nations Interim Security Force for Abyei, the United Nations Mission in Liberia and the United Nations Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste, and up to April/May 2011 for the United Nations Mission for the Referendum in Western Sahara and the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus.
