Letter dated 7 May 2012 from the Permanent Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government and following my letters dated 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 23, 24 and 25 April 2012, I would like to draw your attention to the following:

The Government of the Syrian Arab Republic has taken serious measures aimed at fulfilling its obligations under the six-point plan. It has been providing to the Special Envoy of the United Nations, Mr. Annan, in writing and on a regular basis, information on the measures taken by its side to implement the six-point plan.

In response to the Syrian commitment to the six-point plan, the armed terrorist groups have continued to act in violation of the six-point plan, with a long chain of violations that undermine the plan. They have escalated their terrorist acts, killings of civilians and policemen, and destruction of public and private properties.

We have been regularly providing Mr. Annan, the Secretary-General and the President of the Council with documented and detailed information on the violations perpetrated by the armed groups since the 12 April plan for cessation of violence went into effect. In this regard, kindly find below for your information the numbers of those violations committed by the armed groups for each day during the period from 24 April to 5 May 2012:

- On 24 April 2012, the armed groups committed 139 violations.
- On 25 April 2012, the armed groups committed 123 violations.
- On 26 April 2012, the armed groups committed 149 violations.
- On 27 April 2012, the armed groups committed 101 violations.
- On 28 April 2012, the armed groups committed 94 violations.
- On 29 April 2012, the armed groups committed 92 violations.
- On 30 April 2012, the armed groups committed 84 violations.
- On 1 May 2012, the armed groups committed 111 violations.
- On 2 May 2012, the armed groups committed 124 violations.
- On 3 May 2012, the armed groups committed 107 violations.
- On 4 May 2012, the armed groups committed 74 violations.
- On 5 May 2012, the armed groups committed 86 violations.







The total number of the violations committed by the armed groups during the period from 12 April to 5 May 2012 is 2,339 violations.
