

# Note by the Secretary-General

#### Addendum

- 1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Lisa P. Spratt (United States of America) from the Committee on Contributions, with effect from 3 May 2012. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Ms. Spratt, which expires on 31 December 2012.
- 2. The Government of the United States of America has nominated Susan M. McLurg to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Ms. Spratt.
- 3. In a communication dated 9 May 2012, the Secretariat was informed by the Chair of the Group of Western European and other States that the candidature of Ms. McLurg had been endorsed by the Group.
