REPORT OF THE COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The following communication concerning resolution 6 (XVII) of the Commission on Human Rights on Freedom from Prejudice and Discrimination Year and Day has been received from the Permanent Mission of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics:

UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS

"The Permanent Mission of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations wishes to state, in reply to letter No. PU 151 (II) of 30 March 1961 from the United Nations Secretariat, that at the seventeenth session of the Commission on Human Rights the USSR representative already expressed support for the proposal that a Freedom from Prejudice and Discrimination Year and Day should be observed. The USSR's position with regard to this resolution will be stated in greater detail by the USSR representative when the question is discussed at the thirty-second session of the Economic and Social Council."
