Further to my letter dated 13 June 2012, concerning the shelling of civilians under siege in the city of Homs, and upon the instructions of my Government, I write to request, through you, that the Joint Special Envoy of the United Nations and the League of Arab States on Syria use his good offices with countries that have influence on the Syrian regime to urge them to exert pressure on the regime to comply with its commitments under the six-point plan, in particular to immediately stop the use of heavy weapons in Homs.

I should be grateful if the present letter could be circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 34, and of the Security Council.
