Page 76, paragraph 252, line 7

After the words "several specialized agencies" add foot-note reference 2/ with the following text and renumber the foot-notes correspondingly.

"As an example, one could mention that the study of meteorology (especially air-sea interaction), of environmental ocean research, and of fisheries science are growing closer to each other in needs and interests. This indicates a need to strengthen the marine meteorology component of WMO as well as the ability of the various ocean organizations to interact with WMO and to deal with meteorological aspects of ocean science."

Page 82, paragraph 277

Replace the existing paragraph by the following text:

"The Secretary-General therefore proposes to the General Assembly that it take steps to expand further the existing activities of technical assistance in the continental shelf area; and to ensure that, as far as the whole ocean beyond the limits of present national jurisdiction is concerned, the United Nations is given adequate responsibility for systematic collection and diffusion of information regarding economic marine mineral deposits, techniques appropriate for their development, as well as for assisting in solving related juridical; organizational and political issues."
