LETTER DATED 8 SEPTEMBER 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO
THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government and pursuant to my numerous letters concerning Iraqi violations of the cease-fire, I have the honour to note the following violation of the cease-fire by Iraq. The numerical sequence of this violation follows the sequence of those previously reported. (GCs = geographical coordinates)

2038. On 25 June 1989, a military manoeuvre was carried out by Iraq in Chazabeh, behind the third flood-gate, from the GCs of QV 65300-17250 to QV 64600-16750. In this manoeuvre with the strength of one armored battalion, the tanks' movement on Ghozeileh-Sheeb road was from South West to North East. The tanks, moving toward fourth and fifth flood-gates, fired red bullets when positioned behind the fifth flood-gate. The manoeuvre lasted two hours.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
