Letter dated 6 June 2012 from the Permanent Representative of Poland to the United Nations addressed to the President of the General Assembly

I have the honour to inform you that, according to the rotation agreement among the States members of the Eastern European Group for membership in the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL), the Republic of Poland is relinquishing its seat on UNCITRAL in favour of the Republic of Croatia on the last day prior to the beginning of the forty-fifth session of the Commission, in June 2012.
