Resource requirements

The Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption,

Reaffirming its decision in its resolution 3/1 and the terms of reference annexed thereto regarding the finances of the Mechanism for the Review of Implementation of the United Nations Convention against Corruption and its operations,

1. *Decides* that the Implementation Review Group shall provide oversight and guidance during the intersessional period, subject to final approval by the Conference of the States Parties, with regard to proposed and actual expenditures related to the Review Mechanism and its operations;
2. *Requests* the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime, in furtherance of that oversight function, to support the Implementation Review Group by:
 - (a) Providing the Group with clear and easily digestible figures and information related to the finances of the Review Mechanism and its operations;
 - (b) Seeking review by the Group of all proposed expenses related to the operation of the Review Mechanism, including expenses covered by the regular budget of the United Nations and other sources of funding;
 - (c) Obtaining the endorsement of the Group prior to finalizing its submissions related to the operation of the Review Mechanism for each biennial regular budget of the United Nations;
 - (d) Providing other support to the Group as requested;



3. *Decides* that there shall be a standing agenda item for each meeting of the Implementation Review Group entitled “Finances of the Review Mechanism”.
